Excellence in Clergy Leadership Scholarship -Funding Partner Agreement

History: The General Board of Higher Education and Ministry launched a debt-avoidance scholarship collaboration in 2017 as one component of the UMC Initiative to Address Economic Challenges Facing Pastoral Leaders. Inspired by a \$1,000,000 grant awarded to Wespath (UMC General Board of Pension and Health Benefits) in 2016 by the Lilly Endowment, Inc. Wespath, GBHEM and the National Association of United Methodist Foundations collaborated to launch this scholarship and other financial literacy efforts in partnership with United Methodist foundations, annual conferences and seminaries and schools of theology.

For 2024/2025, meritorious United Methodist seminarians will be eligible for a \$3,500 scholarship from GBHEM, as well as additional support from foundations, annual conferences, and seminaries. The seminarians will also receive intentional opportunities to enhance their personal financial literacy. The purpose of this scholarship program is to create a collaboration across United Methodist organizations in support of future clergy reducing or eliminating educational debt and building upon financial acumen.

This agreement is for the 2024-2025 academic year (2024 calendar year) partnership. Additional donors or church support will also be encouraged.

Criteria for Scholarship Candidates:

- United Methodist pursuing or certified candidate for ministry (elder or deacon)
- Demonstrate merit, progress, and commitment in the candidacy process
- Full-time MDIV student enrolled at one of the 13 United Methodist seminaries/schools of theology
- Demonstrate financial need and how this scholarship will help avoid additional student loans
- Approval/recommendation through funding partner's scholarship committee review

Funding Partner Expectations:

- Commit to fund a specified number and amount of scholarship awards through this scholarship
- Promote the scholarship opportunity to potential students
- Review, judge and make award decisions based on merit of screened qualified applicants within their area
- Submit final award decisions to the GBHEM Scholarships by date required
- Transfer matching funds to GBHEM by date required
- · Assist in monitoring and communicating recipients progress and status through ministry for up to five years

GBHEM Scholarships will:

- Administer the application, process award notifications and check disbursements for applicants
- Screen applicants for general eligibility for the program.
- Coordinate the judge access and reviews for each Funding Partner.
- Recognize all partners in award letters and reporting.
- Monitor recipients EY Financial Services or Saving Grace curriculum completion
- Provide reports to Funding Partners on final awards.
- Disburse the scholarship check to the school. Individual award amounts will vary dependent on award matches from GBHEM, annual conference, or UM foundation.
